An Automotive Technician with either NZ Trade Certificate, National A-Grade Registration, NZ Advanced Trade Certificate or equivalent, such as City and Guilds and 3 years recent relevant work experience.

OR

Have worked full-time carrying out repairs and maintenance to light motor vehicles for at least five years continuously. A clean motor vehicle driver's licence.
